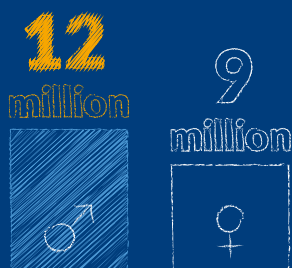

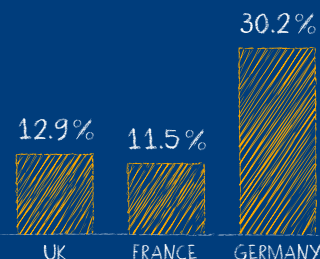
50% of people with schizophrenia **DO NOT GET TREATMENT**²

SYMPTOMS OF SCHIZOPHRENIA



POSITIVE SYMPTOMS:

Paranoia, delusions/ hallucinations, disordered thoughts, speech and behaviour



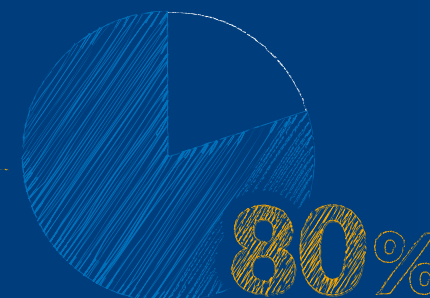
NEGATIVE SYMPTOMS:

Reduced emotional expression, loss of motivation, emotional withdrawal/ social avoidance



COGNITIVE SYMPTOMS:

Impaired attention, memory, problem solving and social cognition
